### ZERO POINT CRYOGENICS



Zero Point Cryogenics (ZPC) manufactures cryogenic devices, including advanced dilution refrigerators, which are the primary low-temperature platform for quantum computers. From technology originally conceived at the University of Alberta in 2017 by physicist, researcher, and Professor Dr. John P. Davis, ZPC specializes in building robust and reliable dilution refrigerators for the quantum computing industry and research partners. As Canada's sole producer (and one of few globally), ZPC empowers labs to push quantum computing boundaries.

In 2023, ZPC achieved several major milestones, including receiving \$1.952M in funding from Prairies Economic Development Canada (PrairiesCan) as part of the Regional Quantum Initiative, \$3M as part of a collaboration with the University of Waterloo, Carleton University and Qubic as parts of the Innovation for Defence Excellence and Security (IDEaS), all while securing multiple government and academic contracts. In addition to growing their team, they delivered their first dilution refrigerator system, a cryogenic device that provides continuous cooling at millikelvin temperatures.

To enhance their business strategies, ZPC received business support and one-to-one coaching through the Experts on Demand program, helping them construct a comprehensive five-year forecast, and facilitating outreach to prospective investors.

ZPC is kicking off 2024 by optimizing its systems to meet the increasing needs of its customers and introducing faster cool-down times, increased cooling power, and extended intervals between scheduled maintenance. Connect with them on LinkedIn to see what's coming for Zero Point Cryogenics.

C<sup>2</sup>, headquartered in Edmonton, empowers fashion consumers to make climate-conscious purchases. Led by CEO & Founder, Amal Merali, their app generates carbon footprint labels for fashion and apparel items and educates consumers about the impact of product-level carbon footprint on land, air and sea. By addressing carbon emissions and broader environmental issues, C<sup>2</sup> advocates for sustainable consumption. As Amal puts it, C<sup>2</sup> is "climate action led by conscious consumers". With the fashion industry being one of the largest contributors to greenhouse gas emissions, C<sup>2</sup> aims to demystify the supply chain and enable consumers to make impactful, sustainable choices to reduce emissions.

Throughout 2023, Amal propelled C<sup>2</sup>'s business journey forward by actively engaging in various startup workshops offered by Edmonton Unlimited, which provided her with the essential tools and guidance necessary to refine and elevate her business ideas. Concurrently, her company's selection as an industry Capstone Project at the University of Alberta reinforced its position in the market, contributing to C<sup>2</sup>'s continued growth and recognition.

This year, C<sup>2</sup> is actively fundraising while also completing the technological advancements needed to support its business development and operations. This dual focus represents a critical growth stage for C<sup>2</sup> as it poises for growth as a trailblazer in the fashion retail industry.

### ACCELERATE

Edmonton Unlimited is part of a consortium led by Alberta Innovates that funds the Alberta Scaleup and Growth Accelerator Program (Scaleup GAP). The consortium, which is comprised of three levels of government including the Government of Alberta, Prairies Economic Development Canada (PrairiesCAN), and the City of Calgary (Opportunity Calgary Investment Fund), allocated \$35 million over three years to contract five world-class accelerators:

- Plug and Play Alberta
- Alberta Accelerator by 500
- TELUS Community Safety & Wellness (CSW) Accelerator, powered by Alchemist X
- SVG Thrive
- Alberta Catalyzer

Developed and delivered in partnership with Platform Calgary, Alberta Catalyzer is a pre-accelerator that offers support, resources and coaching to entrepreneurs who want to grow their tech-enabled companies. Through three levels of programming – Engage, Traction and Velocity – Alberta Catalyzer provides the right combination of supports given a company's stage of development.

## **SPECTRACANN**



Co-Founded in 2022 by CEO, Leyla Kara, COO, Anna Harb, and CTO Charles Harb, SpectraCann is changing the on-site, rapid drug detection market with cutting-edge breathalyzers. Powered by optical physics quantum technology, their drug testing solution can detect multiple substances from a single breath sample, providing results in 30 seconds.

SpectraCann's flagship product, the THC breathalyzer, is set to soft launch by the end of 2024, marking a significant advancement in drug detection technology for enhanced road safety and workplace safety, ultimately reducing accidents and fatalities. Beyond THC detection, SpectraCann's technology offers real-time multi-substance detection for fentanyl, and more, addressing critical issues such as drug overdoses. Their technology will play a significant role in changing the status quo in drug screening, transportation safety, and emergency support services.

In 2023, SpectraCann witnessed a notable surge in momentum, with business support and one-to-one coaching from the Experts on Demand program after successfully graduating from Alberta Catalyzer's Velocity program and clinching the People's Choice Award at the Fall 2023 Northern Velocity Showcase. They also developed their third prototype, began the final stages of securing their first capital raise, and were accepted into the Alchemist X, TELUS Community Safety & Wellness Accelerator (CSW).

At the core of their 2024 strategic path lies the initiation of third-party validation studies and pilot programs, coupled with dedicated efforts to enhance their machine-learning algorithm through a new partnership with the Alberta Machine Intelligence Institute (Amii). In the next six months, they'll actively seek fundraising opportunities from angel investors and venture capitalists to further their mission of fostering a safer society. UpRow's mission to simplify the Canadian settlement process by addressing challenges from housing and employment to legal procedures and building community connections has been successful over the past year.

UpRow expanded its network to 20+ service providers, attracting businesses with their growing user base. Their community of 4,000 newcomers validated UpRow's mission, driving growth of the platform.

From winning both the BIPOC Women Founders in Tech and HerStory Story-pitch competitions, to being named among the top 20 startups in Edmonton at the Startup TNT Investment Summit, UpRow cemented its presence in the Alberta tech scene last year. A graduate of Alberta Catalyzer's Velocity program, Kelise also received business support and one-to-one coaching through the <u>Experts on Demand</u> program.

UpRow kicked off 2024 on a high note with Kelise recently graduating from the Alberta Accelerator by 500 Global, where she refined her go-to-market strategy for the launch of UpRow 2.0. This latest version introduces enhanced features complemented by a more user-friendly interface. These developments and milestones aim to expand UpRow's reach within the newcomer community. Launched in July 2023 through a collaboration with the City of Edmonton, Capital City Pilots invites forward-thinking entrepreneurs to tackle a series of Innovation Challenges and address specific pain points identified by the city. Once a challenge is identified by the city, Capital City Pilots releases it as a call for innovation, inviting submissions for potential solutions. This unique approach empowers local innovators to deploy their solutions and collaborate directly with the city as a client, providing them with invaluable hands-on experience and the opportunity to develop compelling case studies. By participating, innovators not only gain practical insights but also gain tangible opportunities to test their minimum viable products (MVPs) and enhance their appeal to potential customers and investors.

The first three city challenges called for solutions that enhance downtown vibrancy, reimage public spaces and renew neighbourhoods.

**Challenge #1: Data-Driven Downtown.** Innovations to visualize real-time data in the downtown core, encompassing residents, workers and tourists.

**Challenge #2: Environmental Records for Contamination Sites.** Mapping out potential contamination sites for redevelopment throughout Edmonton.

**Challenge #3: Igniting Vibrancy in the Quarters.** Creative innovation to inhabit The Quarters, an area nestled next to North America's largest stretch of urban parkland in Northeast Edmonton.

Edmonton Startup Week is a five-day celebration of community-led workshops, socials, and events showcasing Edmonton's startup community, entrepreneurs, and culture of innovation. Hosted at venues across the city by over 50 community partners, Edmonton Startup Week is a week for entrepreneurs, problem solvers, and their teams to sharpen a new skill, and feel a sense of community.

The 2023 edition of Edmonton Startup Week marked its 10<sup>th</sup> consecutive year, consisting of daily events centred around innovation and professional development, and Launch Party 14. ## **TEAM CAREPAL**



Team CarePal leads the charge in transforming the family caregiving experience through its comprehensive management app, streamlining communication, scheduling, delegation, and task tracking. Founded by CEO Cindy Sim in 2020, their digital solution delivers personalized resources to combat burnout and health issues that more than a million Alberta caregivers face daily.

Team CarePal offers two key solutions: a Caregiver Customer Relationship Management (CRM) system to equip organizations with tools to enable better care coordination, and an Employer Wellness Program to support caregiving employees. Made feasible by the Alberta Machine Intelligence Institute (Amii), Team CarePal plans to predict and prevent caregiver burnout by leveraging data and machine learning.

In 2023, Team CarePal celebrated many milestones including the launch of their customer-facing app, onboarding 400 clients and winning the People's Choice Award at Launch Party 14 during Edmonton Startup Week. Team CarePal also successfully received funding from Alberta Innovates and The National Research Council of Canada Industrial Research Assistance Program (NRC IRAP). After completing several Startup programs in 2022, Team CarePal connected with business leaders and experts through Edmonton Unlimited's Experts on Demand program in 2023, who provided their team with real-time support as the team prepared to bring their product to market.

Team CarePal has already begun 2024 with an exciting itinerary. Among the highlights are the initiation of two pilots with long-term care facilities in Alberta and Saskatchewan, the investigation into expanding their employer wellness program insurance companies, and the highly anticipated launch of their artificial intelligence digital navigation bot.
